### The Base: Hidden Impact of Parental Substance Use

Substance use can have an unseen impact on children and young people who have parents, carers or someone close to them using drugs and alcohol in their lives. This can include historic experience as well as present.

It is estimated that more than 300,000 children in England and Wales are growing up with one or both parents having serious drug problems. This can impact a childs feeling of safety, self esteem, mental health, physical health and accademic achieviement.

We work with any young person who has been impacted by someone elses substance use. We are a Kirklees wide service for young people aged 8-21 years old.

We can offer 1-2-1 sessions with one of our highly experienced Children and Family workers. We can cover many topics including; self esteem, safety planning, improving family relationships, understanding substances and why dependancy can occur. We also run a group project that runs at various times throughout the year.

We work with a wide variety of services to ensure a person centered, holistic approach.

We are a free, confidential, non-judgement and caring service.
