Role of the Treasurer

What is the role of the Treasurer?

Although the role of the Treasurer can be very different from group to group the Treasurer's duties generally cover the following main areas:

To maintain accurate records of all financial transactions made to or by the Waterloo PPG.

Treasurer's tasks:

- To support the Waterloo PPG in the banking of funds and ensuring that cash is available as small change when the PPG hold fundraising events.
- To devise and maintain systems to ensure that financial records are available for each committee meeting.
- To operate bookkeeping procedures that satisfy legal requirements.
- To prepare end of year accounts for approval by the Waterloo PPG and/or external auditors as appropriate.
- To issue monies that have been authorised by named members of the Waterloo PPG.
- To ensure the annual NAPP affiliation fee is paid.
- To undertake other duties as agreed by the Waterloo PPG.
